Jessica's work is shaped by her own experience inside what she calls the Endurance Trap: the cycle of over-functioning, perfectionism, and emotional load that high-achievers carry in silence. After years of pushing through, she realized that the armor she believed made her strong was actually the source of her exhaustion. This turning point became the foundation of her leadership philosophy: sustainable strength requires honesty, vulnerability, and the courage to be seen.

In 2025, Jessica brought this message to the global stage with her TEDx talk, "The Strength Illusion: Why We Fear Vulnerability." Through Raevolution Speaking, she helps leaders and high-achievers stop waiting for confidence and start taking action in the presence of fear so they can lead authentically, build momentum, and create meaningful impact aligned with their purpose.

A first-generation college graduate, she is deeply committed to mentorship and expanding access to opportunity.
